

All Inclusive Package

Dear Guest

On behalf of the staff and the management of “CAVO MARIS BEACH HOTEL & SUITES”, we would like to welcome you and wish you an enjoyable holiday. Your choice of stay is on ‘**All Inclusive**’ package.

Upon check-in, each adult (over 18 years old) will receive a ‘**Credit Card**’, which must be presented when ordering ‘**All Inclusive**’ items throughout your stay. Please sign it on the back and make sure to keep it safe, to ensure that you do not lose it. In the unfortunate event that this happens, you must notify Reception **immediately**.

CHECK OUT time is at 12:00 noon at the day of your departure. The All Inclusive package finishes at that time. If however your departure pick up is after this time, please visit the Reception Desk whereby you will be issued with a ‘**Departure Card**’.

MEALS are served at the “*Alkion Buffet Restaurant*” which operates as follows:

BREAKFAST: 07.15 - 10.30hrs **LUNCH:** 13.00 - 15.30hrs **DINNER:** 19.00 - 21.30hrs

At “*Alkion Buffet Restaurant*” you are allowed to enjoy drinks by the glass, such as wine, beer, local spirits, table water, juices, soft drinks, coffee and tea, which are included in your meal package.

SNACKS are served at the “*Argo Burger Bistro*” Restaurant during the following hours:

Guests who wants to go out for the day can order packed lunches at the Reception the day before (**before 20.00 hrs**).

DRINKS in the ‘**All Inclusive**’ package are available at:-

- “*Coral*” Lounge Bar → 10.00 until 24.00hrs.
- “*Medusa*” Pool Bar & Gelateria → 10.00 until 18.30hrs (*weather permitting*).
- “*Sirena*” Swim Up Cocktail Bar → 10.00 until 18.30hrs (*weather permitting*).
- “*Alkion Buffet*” Restaurant → During Lunch and Dinner meal hours.
- “*Argo Burger Bistro*” → During snack hours.

Local drinks by the glass included in your All Inclusive meal package, which are local wine, local spirits, draught local beer, soft drinks, table water, juices, coffee and tea.

In all the above listed bars, drinks and items that are offered on ‘All Inclusive’ basis are clearly marked with the sign 

✍ All drinks in the 'All Inclusive' outlets must be signed for. It is very important that you give your room number and mention 'All Inclusive' to the staff for all your 'All Inclusive' consumption, otherwise you may cause unnecessary complications in our operation (the Hotel also serves guests who do not have an 'All Inclusive' package).

The following consumptions, services and facilities are **NOT INCLUDED** in the 'All Inclusive' package:-

- Telephone calls
- Purchases from Souvenir/ Minimarket Shop
- Treatments in the "Vitality Spa & Wellness Center"
- A la Carte Restaurants & Take away meals
- Mini Bar & Room Service
- Mini Golf

Free activities **INCLUDED** in the 'All Inclusive' package:-

- Tennis
- Table tennis
- Daytime and evening entertainment.

PLEASE NOTE IMPORTANTLY

- ☞ 1. Parents with children under 18yrs must order and sign on behalf of their children. To comply with Cypriot law, children under 18 years of age are not allowed to consume alcohol.
- ☞ 2. Consumption of drinks is strictly applied to members of families entitled to the 'All Inclusive'.
- ☞ 3. Food and drink offerings to other guests must be paid for.
- ☞ 4. If you choose to order any of the limited items not included in the 'All Inclusive' package, the regular hotel list prices will apply and you will be charged accordingly.
- ☞ 5. To avoid unnecessary waste, only one drink per person at a time, may be ordered.
- ☞ 6. Drinks must be consumed in the section from which they were ordered.
- ☞ 7. For safety reasons, drinks should not be carried around or within the hotel premises (rooms, lawns, inside the pool, etc.).
- ☞ 8. It is not permitted to bring drinks from other departments into the restaurant.

★ The hotel management is obliged to comply with the Cyprus Law regarding the right to refuse service to intoxicated people and also reserves the right to stop serving 'All Inclusive' food and drinks in cases of abuse of 'All Inclusive' rights.
